

Rush City Schools COVID-19 Guidelines

STUDENTS NEED TO GO HOME IF THEY HAVE...

1 OF THE FOLLOWING

- fever of 100.4°F
- new or worsening cough
- difficulty breathing
- loss of taste or smell

OR

2 OF THE FOLLOWING

- headache
- chills
- muscle pain
- sore throat
- fatigue
- nasal congestion or runny nose
- GI symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea

OR

a sibling or household member going home with COVID-like symptoms

WHEN MAY MY CHILD RETURN TO SCHOOL?

POSITIVE COVID TEST

After 10 days from onset of symptoms

and

no fever for at least 24 hours

and

symptoms have improved

NO COVID TEST

After 10 days from onset of symptoms

and

no fever for at least 24 hours

and

symptoms have improved

or

doctor's note with alternative diagnosis

NEGATIVE COVID TEST

After 24 hours of improved symptoms

Sibling/Household Member of Symptomatic Person

After 14 days with no signs or symptoms

Or

After symptomatic person has a negative test or alternate diagnosis
