Good evening. I apologize for contacting you this late in the evening, however, we want to be transparent and notify our families that an individual who was in our building on Monday has tested positive for Covid-19. We have notified the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and are working with them to notify those individuals who have had close contact. We understand that this may create unease in our community. We have taken action to clean and sanitize the facility and we are working closely with MDH to monitor the situation. We will send an update on the situation tomorrow afternoon, after we have received final guidance from the state.

Some Distance Learners are scheduled to come in to take assessments, and they may still do so. Wednesday childcare will be available as usual. Cross Country practice, however, is canceled for both morning and afternoon.

This is a challenging time and I know many of you may be feeling stress or anxiety. We will get through this together as a community, and will be stronger when we emerge.
