Wireless upgrade summary for Jacobson Elementary

Reasons for upgrade:

- 1. Current AP's (qnty 37) are end of life with the manufacturer meaning no support or upgrades are available for the AP's which are Meru 320's.
- 2. The Meru controller and the HS AP's Meru 832's therefore can not be upgraded either while the 320's are in use all AP's have to use the same code as the controller.
- 3. The 320's are old technology and can't take advantage in speed improvements made in recent years with new wifi specifications like Wave 1 (AC) that our devices could be using today.
- 4. Erate funding Erate has changed where as they will now fund 60% of wireless projects. The district then only has to cover the other 40%. There is no guarantee that eRate funds will be available in coming years. All depends on how much monies set aside for the program remains year to year.

Proposed solution

I had six vendors or manufacturers contact me in reply to our 470 application. Five of these vendors ended up coming onsite - looking over the building, seeing what we currently have in place, noted high use areas and provided quotes and recommendations. I ended up with fifteen quotes total.

Of all these - the vendor CIT which represents Aruba wireless (an HP owned company) - provided the best overall price - and I believe the best overall solution for Jacobson Elementary. Aruba is one of the top wireless vendors in the market - and CIT has over eighty employees to help support their clients. HP also will provide resources as needed directly, via a dedicated sales rep and dedicated sales engineer both located in the Twin Cities area - that can answer any technical questions and insure we receive the support needed. Aruba/HP also has the lowest year to year maintenance costs as they provide deep discounts to K-12 schools.
