

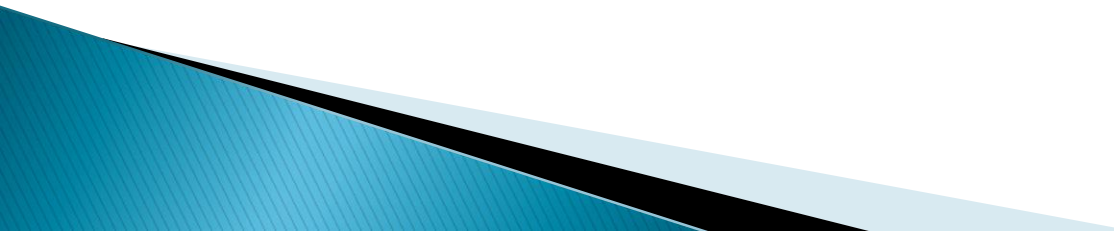
Proposed Change to HS Staffing

Proposal

- ▶ Reduce 1.0 FTE in Physical Education
 - ▶ Replace this FTE as we determine will best address the following intended outcomes
 - Better align electives with student needs/interests
 - Provide more elective options
 - Reduce the size of study halls
 - Assist in lowering core class sizes
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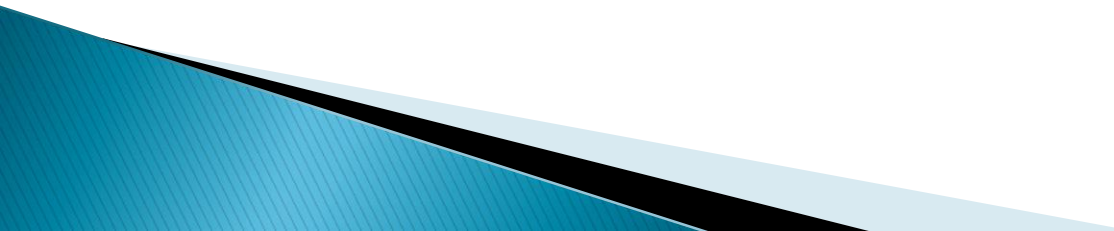
Rational For Change

- ▶ Only 18 total requests for PE electives
- ▶ Little to no fees for sports – great participation
- ▶ Increase academic elective options to decrease noncredit bearing options
 - Large study halls – 111 1st sem., 89 2nd sem.
 - TA's, Peer Tutors, and Career Link over enrolled
- ▶ Enrollment in core electives has increased
- ▶ A 1.0 FTE is able to teach all required PE courses, Health, and DAPE

Current Ideas

- ▶ Family and Consumer Sciences
 - Courses in nutrition, child development, family dynamics, interior design, retail/school store, etc.
 - Use Room 300 – Little lab equipment needed
- ▶ Math
 - Assist with lowering current class sizes, personal finance, retail/school store, sports math, etc.
- ▶ .5 FTE Math / .5 FTE other elective, maybe PE
- ▶ Other options as we continue to evaluate student interests/needs

Time Constraints

- ▶ Administration will need to finalize the master schedule
 - ▶ Guidance office will need to schedule all students and level class sizes.
 - ▶ Hiring process – earlier is better...
