Rush City School District called for Health Insurance bids with due date of 4:00 pm April 19, 2017.

Bids were opened on Thursday April 20, 2017 at 3:15 with the following people present: Representing Rush City Schools – Jim Jackson, Teresa Dupre, and Laureen Frost. Representing the Rush City Education Association – Eric Telander, Mary Kurvers, and Barbara Scierka.

Three bids were received:

- 1. PEIP This bid did not have the same level of benefits currently provided so it failed to meet bid specifications.
- 2. Blue Cross Blue Shield, direct from Blue Cross Blue Shield This bid did not have the same level of benefits currently provided so it failed to meet bid specifications.
- 3. Blue Cross Blue Shield through Resource Training and Solutions This bid met all specifications and maintains the same level of benefits currently provided.

The School Board has given authorization to administration to accept and approve a bid. Blue Cross Blue Shield bid through Resource Training and Solutions is awarded the bid. This bid represents a 7.4% increase from current rates for the October 1, 2017 renewal. The bid also includes a guarantee of no more than a 16.9% increase for the renewal on October 1, 2018.
